## A Storm Water Management Awakening

I foresee a turning of the tide with regard to the adverse impacts of the global recession and resulting



economic downturn. This change will be fueled mainly by constructiontype activity facilitated by the stimulus funding. The effects of the stimulus funding will

manifest more in 2010, compared with the slow start and pull-through in 2009, as construction projects emerge from the pipeline.

The earmarking of some 20% of the stimulus funding toward "green" infrastructure will provide the basis for increased momentum for green infrastructure. This represents a mega-trend, particularly when coupled with the general move toward a green economy and the need for carbon
