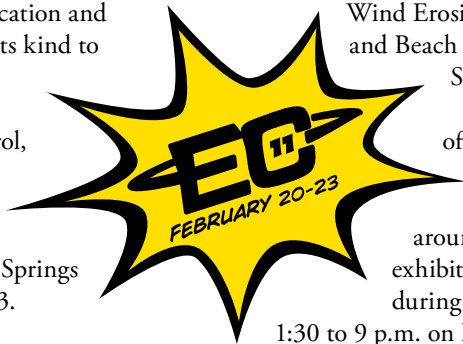
EC11 education sessions will cover eight technology sections: Slope
